

Authentic in their material origins but with five exciting colourways, these gently textured bricks are equally at home in traditional builds and architectural projects – particularly where expressive designs are required.



# Nelissen

Beautifully tactile and appealingly rustic –

These sumptuous bricks originate from Belgium, where they have been carefully crafted by a family of fourth-generation brickmakers of international renown.

—

Made with an exquisite rustic texture, Nelissen bricks are sculptured pieces in themselves. In fact, due to the irregular folded grooves and exquisite colours, each is a genuinely unique work of craftsmanship. Created using a combination of age-old materials, and ultra-modern kiln techniques, Nelissen's multi-shade faces and rich velvety sand surfaces are the result of years of dedicated research and development.

While technology may have changed production techniques over the years the processes have not – using just clay, sand and fire. Each brick is still produced using a careful and intensive hands-on approach, overseen by master technicians and a dedicated Creative Ceramics Department.

The result is a truly stunning range of bricks, which all lend themselves to significant design projects – especially where internal features or larger commercial buildings require a highly-distinctive design statement.







Beautiful as architectural feature highlights, and equally elegant as a feature wall or facade, this collection is designed to inspire creative bold expressions in any environment.





